Special offer of the Museum of Arts in Bielefeld for refugees

The Museum of Arts in Bielefeld got a benefit for refugees-projects from the government of culture in North Rhine-Westphalia. The Museum invites our groups for a free visit of the recent exhibition "Einführung und Abstraktion – Die Moderne der Frauen in Deutschland" (Empathy and Abstraction – The Modern Trend of women in Germany". The visit includes a guided tour (with interpreter) and a following art-course (1.5 h).

The previous experience showed that the visit is not only a nice relief of the everyday life. It is not only about the pleasure of looking at paintings. Especially the recent exhibition provides a lot of suggestions to get to know more about the new home Germany, to look into the role of women in Germany and also to explore art-technics.

- The group shouldn't be more than 20 people, 10 to 15 people would be a perfect size.
- Children and youths in one group should be about the same age.
- The groups can be gender mixed or men and women separated in different groups (the experience showed that there are more discussions and talks when they were gender separated).
- The guided tour can be in German and English. You may ask for an interpreter for other languages.
